WHAT RECORDS DO WE NEED TO START A CASE?

## WHAT RECORDS DO WE NEED TO START CASE?

- · Photos from side and front at mouth level
  - Lips apart at rest
  - Smile
  - · Maximum animation
- Maxillary and mandibular alginate impression / model
- Bite registration
- Face bow (if desired) SAM III preferred by Lab



WHAT HAPPENS ON THE DAY OF SURGERY?

#### WHAT HAPPENS ON THE DAY OF SURGERY?

- Surgeon extracts teeth, removes bone if necessary and places Implants
- Dentist places impression coping and takes an impression inside the immediate denture
- Lab converts immediate denture to Screw Retained Provisional
- · Dentist screws Provisional in and adjusts occlusion

- · 6 feet of countertop
- · Sink with running water
- · Electrical outlet
- · Trash can

## WHAT DO YOU NEED FOR THE CONVERSION?

- · Typical dental equipment
- · Polyvinyl siloxane or polyether impression material
- Impression gun and tips
- · Something to adjust occlusion
- · Material to fill screw holes
- · The Robertson Dental Lab Technician brings everything else
